District Map




Fiscal year 2023 saw a decrease in the total number of people being actively supervised¹ on probation or parole in Idaho. The probation population decreased, while the parole population increased slightly. Overall, the relative counts of people in each district remained similar to the prior fiscal year, and there were only minor changes from year to year when individuals were separated by crime group, age, and ethnicity.

¹Active supervision refers to people on probation or parole not located in a jail, in federal custody, or who have been deported. Active supervision also excludes those on unsupervised probation, who have an Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) detainer, bench warrant, or who have absconded or were otherwise put on probation violator or parole violator status.



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Total Population

The total active community population has decreased 2.2% from FY22.

The parole population increased 2.6%.

The probation population decreased 4.1%.

Of the total active community population, 42.6% were sentenced on drug charges. The total number of people serving on drug charges has decreased 3.2% in the last fiscal year. Property crimes saw the greatest change, with a decrease of 5.9%.


Crime Groups


District

Of the total active community population, 27.3% were in District 4. The District 4 population has increased 1.3% in the last fiscal year. District 1 saw the greatest change, with a decrease of 10.2%.


¹District 0 – Limited Supervision Unit (LSU): Individuals whose risks and needs merit less supervision than higher risk individuals.



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
Gender



Pinit Demographics

Of the total active community population, 73.5% were male. The male population decreased 1.7% in the last fiscal year. The female population decreased 2.9%.

Of the total active community population, 31.2% were aged between 35 and 44. The total number of community individuals aged between 35 and 44 is the same as in FY2022, however the 35 to 44 group now comprises the largest proportion of people on supervision, compared to FY2022 when it was people aged 25 to 34. Individuals 65 or older saw the greatest change, with an increase of 9.8%.



Of the total active community population, 73.0% were white. The white population has increased 1.9% in the last fiscal year. Of the remaining individuals with a known race/ethnicity, Asian individuals saw the greatest change, with an increase of 8.8%, although they remain the smallest group.
