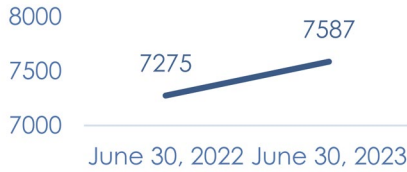

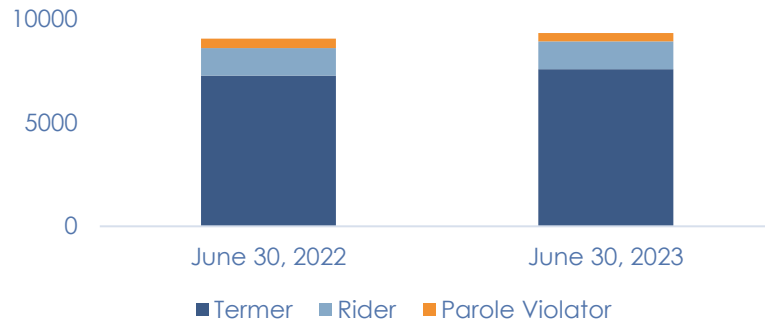
There was a 3.1% increase in the incarcerated population from FY2022 to FY2023.

The term population increased 4.3%.

The rider population increased 1.1%.

The parole violator population decreased 11.5%.

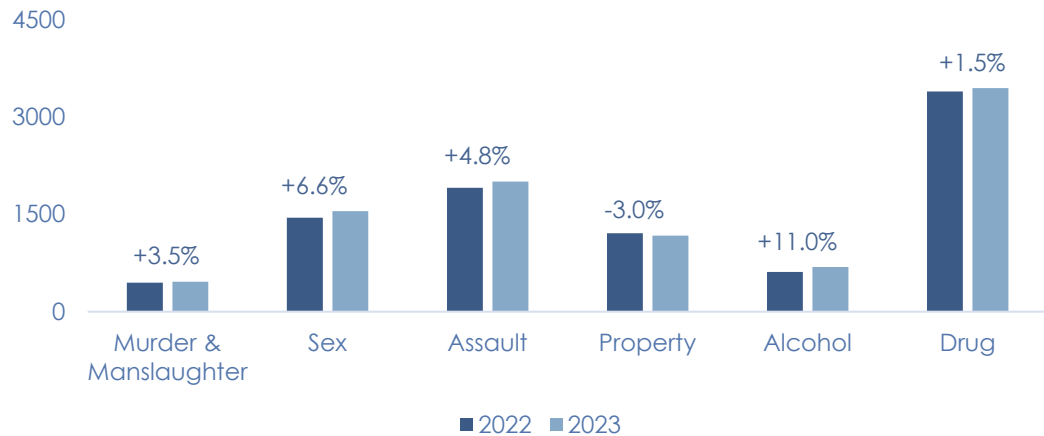
Total Population



Crime Groups

Of the total incarcerated population, 37.0% were sentenced on drug charges¹. The total number of people serving on drug charges has increased 1.5% in the last fiscal year. With the increase in the incarcerated population all crime groups saw an increase except for property, which declined by 3.0%

¹ People may have multiple charges, but drug charges were the longest sentence a person was serving.

Numbers as of June 30, 2023

Following a decline in the incarcerated population during the coronavirus pandemic, Idaho's incarcerated population largely returned to pre-pandemic levels in FY2023. The Idaho incarcerated population had a net increase of 3% during fiscal year 2023. The term population had the largest increase of roughly 300 individuals. The rider population increased slightly but was largely unchanged from the end of FY2022, while the parole violator population decreased slightly.

¹CAPP was renamed Mountain View Transformation Center (MVTC) on July 1, 2023, and is now a state-operated prison.

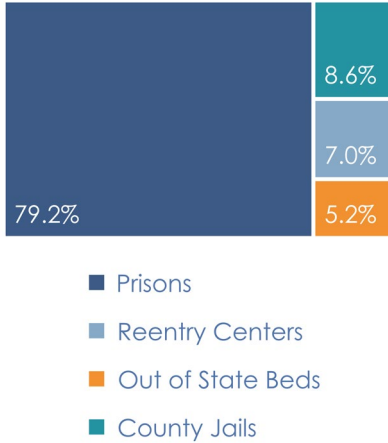
²Parole Violator: An individual who violates the conditions of their parole. This is usually a temporary status until a hearing can be conducted to determine if their parole will be reinstated or revoked.

³Retained Jurisdiction (Rider): Individuals sentenced to a period of incarceration in an IDOC facility over whom the court has retained jurisdiction. The IDOC assesses riders to determine their needs and places them in the appropriate facilities to receive intensive programming and education. Upon completion of a rider, the court determines whether to place the resident on probation or sentence them to term.

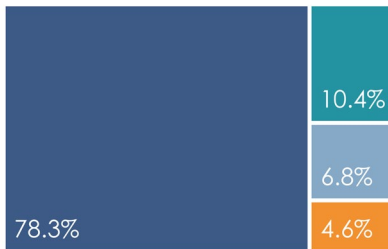


Facility Type

Of the total incarcerated population, 78.3% were held in IDOC prisons. The in-state prison population has increased 1.7% in the last fiscal year, while the reentry center population has decreased 0.2%. Reliance on out of state beds decreased, while use of jails increased, with the contract bed population decreasing 8.6% and the county jail population increasing 24.4%.

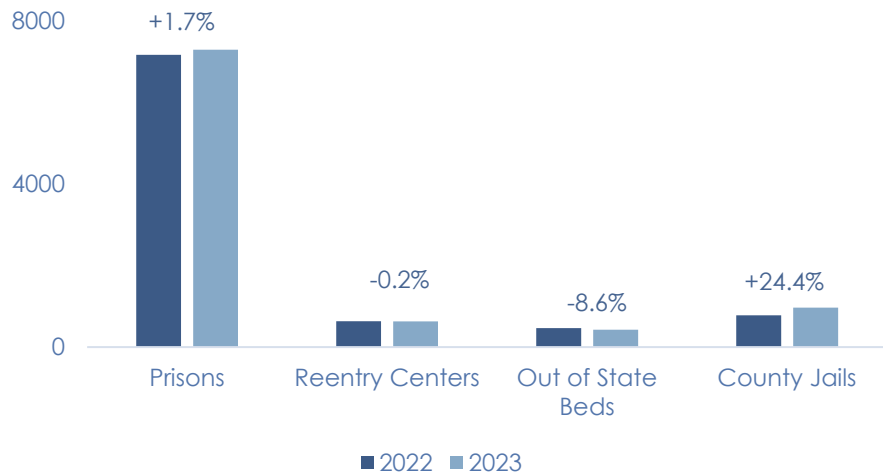

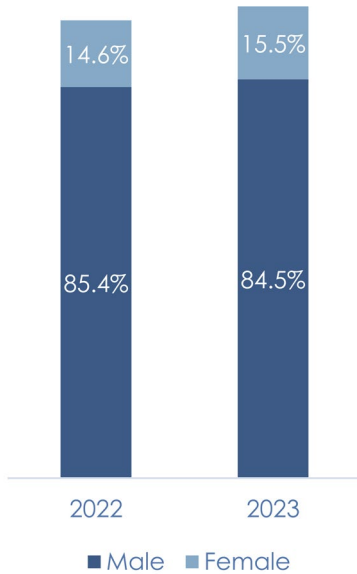

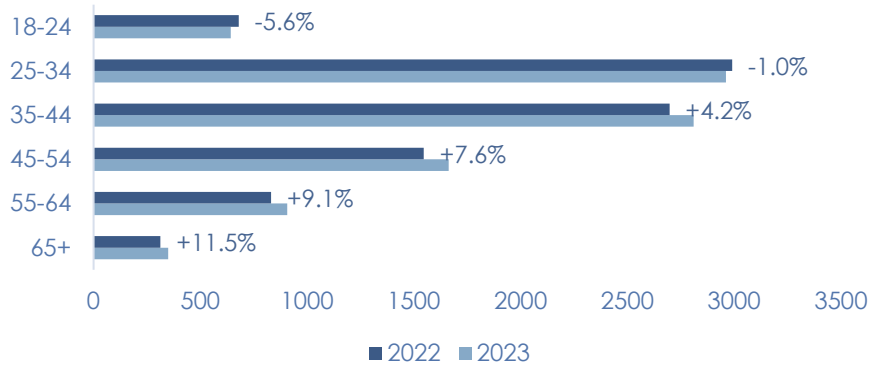


Demographics

Of the total incarcerated population, 84.5% were male. The male population increased 2.0% in the last fiscal year. The female population increased 9.3%.

The largest proportion of people incarcerated fell between the ages of 25 to 34, representing 31.7% of the total incarcerated population. However, the total number of incarcerated individuals aged between 25 and 34 has decreased 1.0% in the last fiscal year. Individuals aged 65 or older saw the greatest change, with an increase of 11.5%.

Age



Of the total incarcerated population, 73.4% were white. The white population has increased 3.1% in the last fiscal year. Of the remaining individuals with a known race/ethnicity, Asian individuals saw the greatest change, with an increase of 28.6%, although they remain the smallest group.
