

Need Principle (what)

Target interventions toward each offender's unique need profile to reduce overall risk.

LSI Domain	Central 8 Risk Indicators & Dynamic Needs
Criminal History	<p style="text-align: center;">History of Antisocial Behavior</p> <p>Risk: Early and continuing involvement in a number and variety of anti social acts in a variety of settings. Need: Build non-criminal alternative behavior in risky situations.</p>
Emotional/ Personal	<p style="text-align: center;">Anti Social Personality</p> <p>Risk: Impulsive, adventurous, pleasure seeking, relentlessly aggressive and irritable. Need: Build problem solving skills, self management skills and coping skills.</p>
Attitude/ Orientation	<p style="text-align: center;">Anti Social Cognitions</p> <p>Risk: Attitudes, values, beliefs and rationalization. Need: Reduce anti social cognition, reduce risky thinking, build up alternatives to risky thinking.</p>
Companions	<p style="text-align: center;">Anti Social Associates</p> <p>Risk: Criminal Friends, isolation from pro-social others. Need: Reduce association with criminal others, enhance association with anti criminal others.</p>
Alcohol/Drug Problems	<p style="text-align: center;">Substance Abuse</p> <p>Risk: Abuse of alcohol and/or drugs. Need: Reduce substance abuse and increase interpersonal supports for substance abuse.</p>
Family/ Martial	<p style="text-align: center;">Family / Marital Relationships</p> <p>Risk: Inappropriate parental monitoring and disciplining, poor family relationships. Need: Reduce conflict and build positive relationships, enhance monitoring and supervision.</p>
Education/ Employment	<p style="text-align: center;">School / Work</p> <p>Risk: Poor performance, low levels of satisfactions. Need: Enhance performance, rewards and satisfactions.</p>
Leisure/ Recreation	<p style="text-align: center;">Pro Social Recreational Activities</p> <p>Risk: Lack of involvement in pro-social hobbies and sports. Need: Enhance rewards, involvement and satisfaction.</p>
Accommodation	Not a criminogenic need, but links to stability and program success. (ASAM Dimension 6)
Financial	Not a criminogenic need, but links to case management needs.
