POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the Idaho Board of Correction that the Idaho Department of Correction (IDOC) establish advisory boards, as needed, for the purpose of advising the IDOC on the philosophies and wishes of the community.

It is also the policy of the Board that the IDOC not be bound to follow advisory board recommendations.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to communicate the Board's philosophy regarding advisory boards.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all IDOC employees, advisory board members, and any procedures created under the authority of this policy.

RESPONSIBILITY

The director of the IDOC and division chiefs are responsible for overseeing the implementation of this policy and the development, implementation, and monitoring of standard operating procedures (SOPs) that address any of the following in regards to advisory boards:

- Board member criteria;
- Board member duties and responsibilities;
- Number of members to serve on the board;
- Recruiting members;
- IDOC staff responsibilities; and
- Meeting date, times, format, and other requirements.
